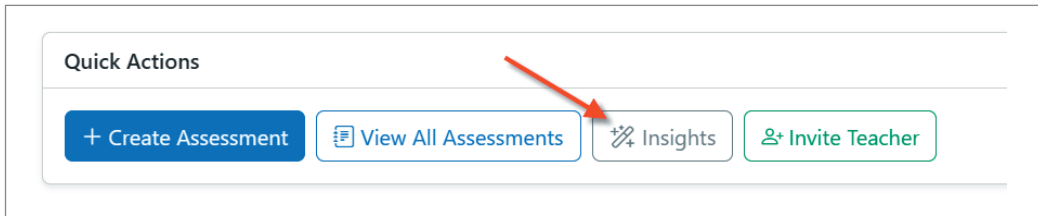
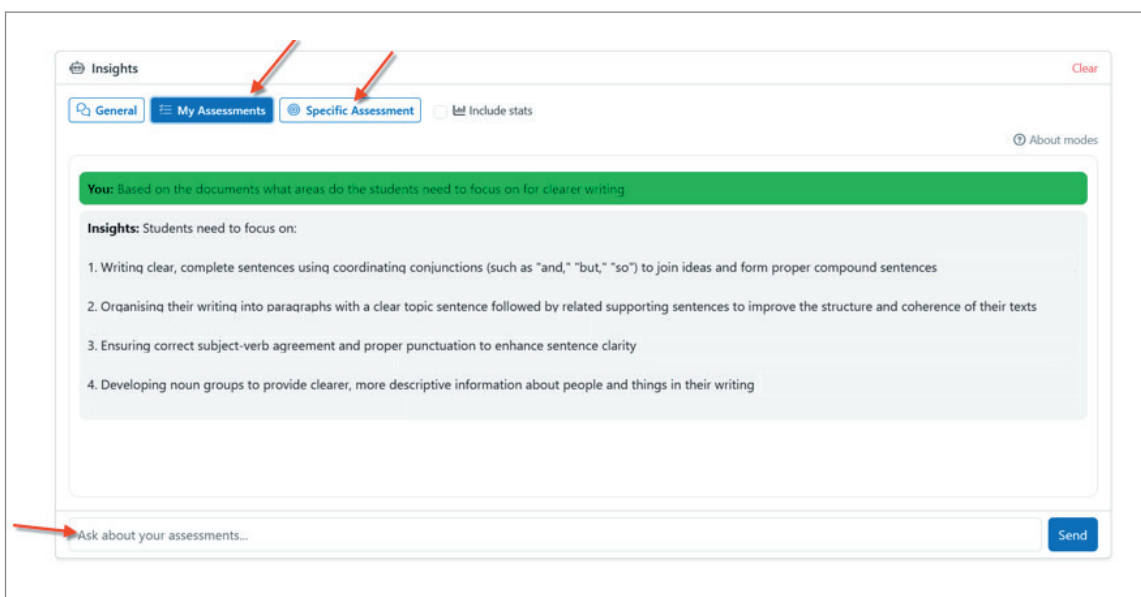

You will now be able to ask questions about the data you have assessed with Rubric IQ

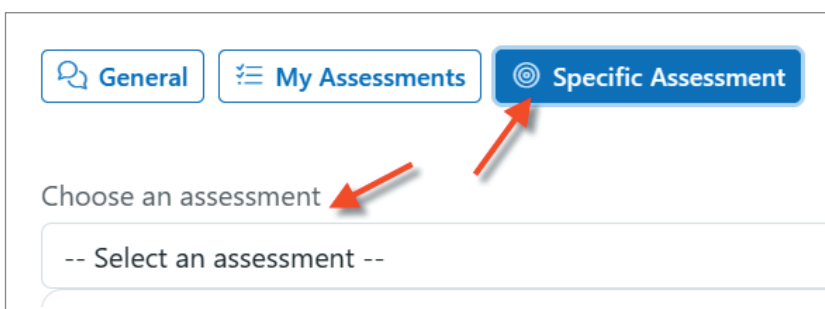


INSIGHT QUESTION OPTIONS

General – Allows you to ask a general question of Rubric IQ

My Assessments – Allows you to ask a question about all or any of the assessments you have loaded in for feedback.

Specific Assessment – Allows you to ask a specific question about the selected assessment.



You can ask any question you want the information on or you can ask a series of questions to help you focus on what you want to get out of the data.

EXAMPLE QUESTIONS YOU CAN ASK.

- Please count the number of documents that have been submitted in this assessment.
- Please outline the common areas that students need to improve on.
- Please create groups based on this assessment and their writing levels.
- In these documents what are the most common mistakes that are being made.
- Please look at the pre-writing assessment and the post writing assessment and outline the areas that have improved on a class level.
- Based on the documents what areas do the students need to focus on for clearer writing
- Please create groups based on the writing level in these documents. Please make the groups 3-4 in size.
- Identify the four worst features of writing across all students for this task and give me a 10min mini-lesson each day as a 3-week teaching cycle to hone the students skills. Also provide me a poor work sample that I can use in these lessons to help develop the skills and support the lesson.

Essentially anything you want to know about the data you can ask and receive instant feedback.
